

Hyder Project Reaches 1 Million Man Hours

By the first of August, Hyder Construction's team reached 1 million man hours at Vail's Front Door. The \$115 million project, which began in the spring of 2006, peaked at 500 employees on site in May 2008, but has averaged 300-350 employees per day. According to Safety Director, Brad Letterly, "2,280 craftsmen had completed the required safety orientation program as of July 31, 2008." Our insurance provider, Aon acknowledged that Hyder has the best safety record of all the current OCIP projects in the Vail Valley. Senior Consultant, Carl Frank, states, "*There are few GCs that have the safety culture throughout the organization that Hyder has shown on this job.
